#### **Pilots with a non-European license must have it validated**

Validation of license

The pilots must be able to document in the form of declaration of the respective countries authorities that their certificate is in accordance with ICAO Annex I. If the evidence is not sufficient, pilot training may be needed to fulfil the requirements as imposed to be flying in a Poland registered aircraft.

Furthermore, pilots must document a radio license with a language level of English equivalent to a minimum of grade 4 according to FCL.055 and a valid medical certificate.

**7. Landing competition and training.**
